WHEREAS, mental health professionals agree that the negative effects of parental alienation can follow a child into adulthood with tragic consequences; and

WHEREAS, the recently published Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM-5) made several references to the dysfunctional family dynamic of alienation as being a form of psychological child abuse; and

WHEREAS, Parental Alienation Prevention Week is intended to increase the knowledge and understanding of this problem to help Alabamians, institutions, the legal and mental health communities, and leaders to better identify and combat such abusive behavior to children; and

WHEREAS, the organizers of Parental Alienation Prevention Week are asking everyone to blow soap bubbles at noon on April 25th, 2016 to show their support in spreading the simple message that children should be allowed to freely love both of their parents and extended family members; each free flowing bubble representing the love a child should have for his or her mother and father.
