Whereas, with awareness comes education, understanding and the power to stop the abuse of innocent children caught in the crossfire of the people they love; and,



Therefore, I, Mayor Hinkle, on behalf of the City Council, in recognition of this important event, do hereby proclaim April 25, 2012 as


Parental Alienation Awareness Day
