WHEREAS, with awareness comes education and the understanding and power to protect innocent children caught in the crossfire of the people they love; and

WHEREAS, professionals agree that when parental alienation exists, it is damaging to children and can affect them into adulthood with tragic consequences; and

**WHEREAS**, parental alienation may be considered a form of child abuse as the alienating tactics used on the child are confusing, frightening, and rob the child of their sense of security; and


**WHEREAS**, parental alienation deprives children of their right to love and to be loved by both parents; and
