Executive Order

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Alienating behaviors are often found in high conflict divorce and custody

situations; and

WHEREAS, Behaviors such as speaking negatively about a parent to or in front of a child, interfering with communication and visitation, and discussing inappropriate information with a child, such as details of the marriage,

court proceedings, or financial matters can destroy the bond between a loving parent and child; and

WHEREAS, Parental Alienation takes advantage of the dependency of children with the

sole purpose of destroying a loving relationship they once shared with a

parent; and

WHEREAS, The most common symptom of children affected by Parental Alienation is

their severe opposition to, or fear of, contact with one parent when there is

no justifiable cause to explain the child's behavior; and

WHEREAS, Parental Alienation is a form of child abuse as the alienating tactics used on

the children are confusing, frightening, and rob children of their sense of

security; and

WHEREAS, With awareness comes education and understanding, and the power to stop

the abuse of innocent children caught in the crossfire of the people they

love;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim April 25, 2009 as

Parental Alienation Awareness Day

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
